



ENCHANTING SICILY 8 days / 7 nights

Day 1: Arrival at PALERMO airport, transfer to hotel, dinner and overnight.

Day 2: PALERMO - MONREALE

Walking tour through one of the richest town in Sicily for history and art, Palermo.

Visit the Norman Cathedral, the Royal Palace with the Palatine Chapel, the Four Corners, and the local market. Afternoon visit to Monreale, a Medieval town known for its Arab-Norman Cathedral with its splendid 12th century mosaics, and the adjacent Benedictine cloister. Return to Palermo hotel, dinner and overnight.

Day 3: CEFALU'- CATANIA

Today we'll transfer to Catania. En route we'll stop to the charming coastal town of Cefalù and stroll around the streets of the town centre, until we reach the Norman Cathedral with its outstanding mosaics. Transfer to Catania, half day sightseeing tour, including the Duomo and city centre. Accommodation at hotel, dinner and overnight.



Day 4: SYRACUSE - CATANIA

Syracuse: the day begins at the Archaeological Park of the Neapolis with the 5th century BC Greek Theatre, the Ear of Dionisyus and the Roman Amphitheatre.

We will then continue with a walking tour of the small baroque island of Ortigia, to see the Temple of Apollo, the Cathedral, and the Spring of Aretusa. Later we drive back to our hotel in Catania for

dinner and overnight.

Day 5: ETNA – TAORMINA

Today your private driver will conduct you along the fabulous Sicilian coast to discover Taormina and Mt Etna. See one of the world's most active volcanoes, and experience the charming town of Taormina. Visit its Greek-Roman Theatre, the public gardens, and enjoy some free time in the town. Dinner and overnight in Catania.



Day 6: CALTAGIRONE and AGRIGENTO

Visit of Caltagirone, known for the production of ceramics, and get some time for shopping. Proceed to Agrigento to visit the Valley of Temples, a wonderful walking tour through nature, culture, and unforgettable tuff temples.

Transfer to our hotel in Agrigento for dinner and overnight.

Day 7: SELINUNTE – PALERMO

Selinunte is the hugest archaeological park of Europe. Famous in the whole world, and founded in the VII century BC, Selinunte quickly became a big and powerful city, flourishing in trade and in art. Today, inside the unique atmosphere of the archaeological park, are preserved huge rests of eight temples.

At the end of the visit transfer to Palermo for free time, dinner and overnight.

Day 8: After breakfast, transfer at PALERMO airport and end of the tour.
